**Learning Outcomes for a Bachelor of Arts in Theatre Arts
with an Emphasis in Performance**

When students graduate with an emphasis in Performance, they will possess:

1. The ability to create a realistic, age-appropriate Character.
2. A clear, effective Rehearsal Process and an understanding of Rehearsal Protocol in the Professional Theatre.
3. The ability to memorize and perform a monologue, scene or play including an understanding of the following concepts; playing an intention, satisfying an objective and matching physical and vocal characterization to Performance Venue and Style.
4. A repertoire of Audition pieces (monologues, songs, etc.) and the ability to create new audition packages.
5. A working knowledge of Iambic Pentameter and the ability to create and perform characters specific to Shakespeare's Canon.
6. The ability to create and perform a role with a Dialect.
7. The ability to adapt their work for Television and Film.
