School of Art, Art History & Design

The School of Art, Art History & Design in the Hixson-Lied College of Fine and Performing Arts offers four degrees and three majors: the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Fine Arts and the Master of Fine Arts in studio art; the Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Fine Arts in Graphic Design; and the Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts in Art History. Studio art students may emphasize in ceramics, drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture and interdisciplinary studio art.

There are more than 300 undergraduate art majors and 35 graduate students. The University of Nebraska–Lincoln program is the only MFA visual arts degree in the state. Ceramics and Printmaking are counted among the very top graduate programs in the nation. Each graduate student has either an individual or shared studio space in which to work. With few exceptions, all graduate students have generous financial support.

The School of Art, Art History & Design is located in two building on the city campus in Woods Art Building and Richards Hall. Each building houses excellent studio classrooms with the most current equipment and computer technology for creative projects, including an art fabrication space in Richards Hall. Studio facilities in Papermaking and Book Arts are special additions to choices for student exploration and creativity. Student groups such as the Art League, Lincoln Print Group, Clay Club, Fine Art Photo Club and American Institute of Graphic Artists (AIGA) Students in Design groups enhance the student experience with exhibitions and art activities throughout the year,

The department gallery, the Eisentrager-Howard Gallery, is located in Richards Hall. The gallery offers opportunities to enjoy, appreciate and participate in the visual arts, contributing to the arts nationally and internationally. Students exhibit their work in the gallery through the annual student competition, the senior BFA Capstone Exhibition and the MFA Thesis Exhibitions. School of Art, Art History & Design alumni achieve excellence and accomplishment as artists and scholars. The department is NASAD accredited.
