The Donald Walters Miller Scholarship is a **university-wide** competition. To be eligible, students must be full-time **sophomores, juniors, seniors, or graduate students** in the Hixson-Lied College of Fine and Performing Arts for the 2022-2023 academic year. Academic excellence, recommendations from professors, honors received, professional goals, and participation in college-sponsored activities will be taken into consideration in selecting students for recommendation.

OLDFIELD SCHOLARSHIP

The Vada Kinman Oldfield Scholarship is a **college** competition. Two awards are given each year. Eligible students must be full time **juniors or seniors** in the Hixson-Lied College of Fine and Performing Arts for the 2022-2023 academic year. Applicants must show promise or talent and must have need (**FAFSA form is required**).

For convenience, students may apply for the Miller and the Oldfield Scholarships using the same application, though the qualifications and eligibility are slightly different. The College's Academic Distinction and Awards Committee reviews the applications and recommends two for Miller Scholarships. The final decisions on the Miller Scholarships are made by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid. The Oldfield Scholarships are selected by the Academic Distinction and Awards Committee.
